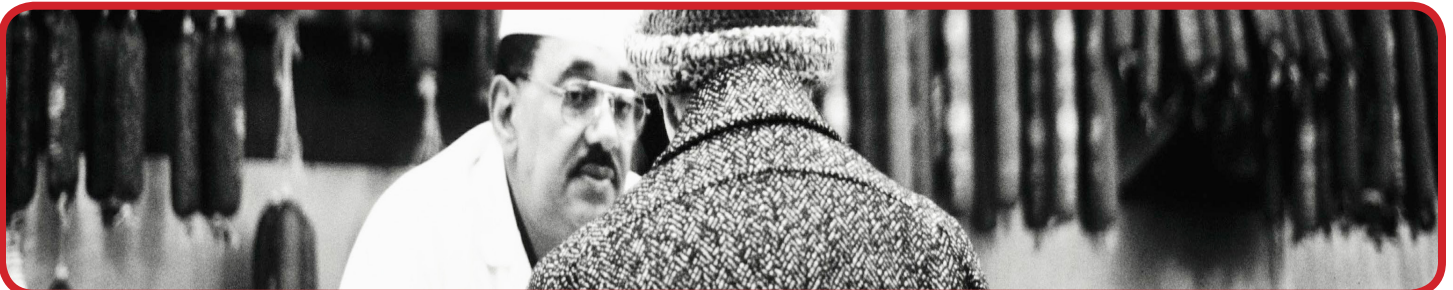
**B'yachad presents a Special ZOOM Presentation
