Temple Emeth – Voluntary Financial Commitment

How Will I Know What to Commit?

The goal of Temple Emeth is to be a diverse and welcoming congregation while meeting our financial obligations. We instituted the Voluntary Financial Commitment (VFC) program because we do not want any member to feel that finances are a barrier to their engagement with us and the larger Jewish community.

Temple Emeth wants you as a member. By asking you to commit to an amount that is appropriate for you, we hope that you will choose to be both generous and realistic. Your pledge covers our operating and capital budgets, including salaries for our wonderful clergy and staff, and the day-to-day operations of running our synagogue and maintaining our beautiful building. The operating budget also supports the cost of hosting a wide variety of activities, including:

- Every religious service and holiday celebration Shabbat and Festivals
- A wide variety of programming, including Adult Education, Trachtenberg Lecture, Scholar-in-Residence Program, Shabbatons, and Torah Study
- High Holy Day tickets, including for adult children
- Religious School tuition (grades K-7) for your children
- Simchas, like Baby Namings and Birthday Blessings
- Sorrows, like Shiva Minyans and Funerals
- A community that celebrates, sings, mourns, and learns together

The monies collected from our VFC pledges are a vital part of the Temple's income. On average, it costs approximately \$1,700 per member family to operate the Temple. We realize that some members may feel inspired to pay more than that amount, and others out of necessity will pay less. Whatever you pledge, we want you and value your membership.

The purpose of VFC is for you to explore what you can afford and what being a Temple member means to you. We hope you will be realistic, as the Temple is depending on you to fulfill your commitment. We also hope you will be generous.
