

## Virtual Memorials and Greetings

Many of us find meaning in having the name of our loved ones printed in a memorial booklet and read during Yizkor. This year, in place of the booklet and reading, we will be showing a video montage of our memorials during Yizkor services, with photos, if you wish.

Similarly, many congregants like to have greetings and dedications in our High Holy Days Program. We will provide the ability to do so by showing the greetings in a video loop between appropriate services.

For the memorials, we welcome a photograph or other graphic related to your loved one. Each slide will contain your photo and the name of the loved one and their relationship to you, such as, "In memory of Rena Samberg, mother of Ed Samberg, remembered by the Samberg Family."
