The Union for Reform Judaism suggests Fair Shar Membership should be 2% of the Congregant's annual income. B'nai Chaim will accept all qualified members. We ask that you keep in mind that all our funds are used for the salary of the Rabbi and staff, and the mortgage and maintenance of our building as you determine the correct amount of your annual contribution.

It is also asked that you contribute to the Building Fund. The suggested minimum contribution is 3 times your annual dues, paid over five years. This contribution is separate from and in addition to the Annual Membership Dues and is for renovation, expansion and major repair to our building. In addition to Dues, there may be additional fees for Religious Education, Youth Group and some Special Functions.

Monthly payments are due on the 15th of each Month, Annual payments are due in full by May 15th, 2024. Quarterly payments may be made before the 15th of July, October, January and April.
