

Following the Rosh Hashanah service and lunch we will go to the Redondo Beach Pier for a *Tashlich* ceremony. We will symbolically cast our sins into the sea in accordance with tradition. You are invited to join us.

Just as one must do teshuvah for transgressions committed through physical acts, one also must reassess one's character traits and correct the negative ones. One must therefore do teshuvah for feeling anger, hatred, jealousy, frivolity, pride and personal cravings (Implied in the Rambam...)

Tashlich Prayers

Hashiveinu Adonai Eilecha v'nashuvah.

Chadeish yameinu k'kedem.

...know the God of David, and serve God with a perfect heart and a willing mind, for Adonai searches all minds and discerns the intent of every thought; if you seek God, Adonai will be available to you, but if you forsake God, Adonai will abandon you forever. (1 Chronicles 28:9)

Who is like you, God, forgiving iniquity and remitting transgression: You have not maintained Your wrath forever against the remnant of Your people, because you love graciousness!

You will take us back in love; you will cover up our iniquities. You will cast all our sins into the depth of the sea. You keep the faith with Jacob, loyalty to Abraham, as You swore to our ancestors in days gone by.

DIRECTIONS to the Redondo Beach Pier

Meet to the right of Kincaid's Restaurant

From the Temple: Turn Right on Arlington Ave. Turn Left on Sepulveda Blvd. (West). Sepulveda becomes Camino Real. Turn Left onto Torrance Blvd. towards Redondo Beach Pier. (Past Catalina Blvd) First Right to upper parking structure leading to Kincaid's Restaurant. Walk to the right of the restaurant on the walkway facing the water.
