Flights: Flights to Poland and from Poland to Israel are not included and are being arranged by each traveler. Keshet assumes no responsibility for flight arrangements, delays or cancellations. When booking flights, please note the following:

First night of included hotel accommodations	Friday May 17, 2019 at the Mercure Centrum Hotel in Warsaw. Check-in is from 3:00 PM . There will be one group bus transfer from Warsaw Chopin Airport to the Mercure Centrum Hotel in Warsaw on Friday May 17 timed to the arrival of most of the group.
Conclusion of included hotel accommodations	Check out from the Radisson Blu Hotel in Krakow on Wednesday morning May 22. The group will arrive back Warsaw's Chopin Airport on Wednesday evening May 22 for flights to Israel timed for departure on El Al flight #562 to Israel at 10:30 PM, arriving Israel Thursday May 23 at 3:45 AM. There will be one group bus pick up at Ben Gurion Airport in Israel after the arrival of El Al flight #562 from Warsaw to the Renaissance Hotel in Tel Aviv for early check-in and breakfast.

If you will be arriving/departing from/to Poland & Israel at times other than the provided group airport transportation, you will

be responsible for the cost of your own airport transportation. The Keshet staff will be happy to help you reserve and pre-pay

for private transportation and to help you with any additional accommodations or touring services that you might need to arrange

prior to or after the group trip in Poland & in Israel.
