## EMOR - Page 672 in the Stone Chumash

- 1st Aliya:** Specific restrictions for Kohanim and the Kohain Gadol pertaining to marriages, sexuality, and mourning.
- 2nd Aliya:** Laws pertaining to physical blemishes of the Kohanim and who can and can not eat from the priestly gifts.
- 3rd Aliya:** Laws defining what constitutes an acceptable and unacceptable blemish on an animal designated to be a **Korban**.
- 4th Aliya:** The establishment of Shabbos, Pesach, the Omer, the counting of the Omer and Shavuot.
- 5th Aliya:** The establishment of Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur.
- 6th Aliya:** The establishment of Sukkot.
- 7th Aliya:** Laws of the Ner Tamid, the Showbread, the incident with the Blasphemer, and the penalties for Blasphemy.

## HAFTARA FOR EMOR Page 1176 in the Stone Chumash *Yechezkel 44:15*

This week's Haftorah is among the prophecies of Yechezkel describing the third Bait Hamikdash. Yechezkel's prophesied after the destruction of the first Bait Hamikdash in the year 3352-410 b.c.e. In the Haftorah, Yechezkel instructed the Kohanim in their unique laws. It relates to this week's Parsha which also details many of the laws imposed specifically on the Kohanim.

## LAG B'OMER - Background and some halachot

On the day of Lag B'Omer we increase our level of celebration a little. Some of the reasons for this practice include: on Lag B'Omer the students of Rabbi Akiva stopped dying. Lag B'Omer is the Hilulah (anniversary of the passing) of Rabbi Shimon Bar Yochai, Lag B'Omer is the day that Rabbi Akiva gave Semicha to his new students, and is the day that the Maan began to fall in the desert.

1. Tachanun is omitted on Lag B'Omer. It is also omitted at Mincha of the day before Lag B'Omer.
2. Music and dancing are permitted in order to honor the Hilulah of Rabbi Shimon Bar Yochai.
3. Ashkenazim may cut their hair on the morning of Lag BaOmer. Sephardim shouldn't cut their hair until the morning of the 34th of the Omer.
4. A groom, as well as the fathers of the groom and bride may shave on the 32nd day of the Omer before sunset of the 33rd. Other family members and guests should not shave before sunset.
