

עֲרוּב תַבְשִׁילִין EIRUV TAVSHILIN

TO BE SAID ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 8TH, AFTER BURNING AND NULLIFYING THE CHAMETZ (See below)

It is not permitted to cook for Shabbat when a Yom Tov occurs on either Thursday or Friday unless an Eiruv Tavshilin is made prior to the Yom Tov. Take a piece of Matzah, together with a boiled egg or cooked fish or meat that will be eaten on Shabbat. Hold them and say:

טָבָא לְשַׁבְתָּא [לָנוּ וּלְכָל יִשְׂרָאֵל הַדְרִים בְּעִיר הַזֹּאת].

Blessed are you, L-rd our G-d, King of the Universe, who has sanctified us with His commandments and commanded us about the Mitzvah of Eiruv.

By this eiruv, may we be permitted to bake, cook, insulate food, light a flame, and to do all that is necessary on Yom Tov for the sake of Shabbat (for us and for all Jews living in this city).
