RABBI SEARCH UPDATE

We are pleased to present a second update on the activities of the Rabbi Search Committee. To date we have received 29 resumes and five telephone inquiries resulting from our advertisements for this position. The Search Committee has reviewed all the resumes and invited three Rabbis (two of whom live in Florida) to spend a Shabbat with us in May. One of the invited Rabbis had a salary request that we could not meet, one Rabbi did not adequately meet our job requirements, and one Rabbi was acceptable to the committee and remains a viable candidate for this position.

Since mid-April the Search Committee has met seven times, four times to discuss the job requirements and review resumes, and three times to discuss each of the three Rabbis who visited DOS.

We feel that we are approaching a new phase in our search as more than half of our Search Committee will have headed North by early in June, along with numerous other DOS members. We therefore do not plan to invite additional prospects to visit DOS at this time. However, there are three additional candidates from the Northeast who we do wish to interview. The committee members who are heading North will set up face-to-face meetings in the NYC area within the next two weeks, which will also utilize Skype, to enable participation of the remaining members of the committee. If any of these Rabbis prove to be acceptable, they will also be considered as finalists in our search. At that point we will submit our recommended candidate to the Board of Directors for their approval.

Recognizing that the majority of our members are not in Delray Beach for the summer, we will utilize various computer-based techniques to acquaint you with our choice prior to requesting your approval by Letter Ballot to hire a new Rabbi. Waiting until the winter to invite a Rabbi for another weekend visit at DOS would greatly delay the Rabbi joining us, and hamper our efforts to recruit new members during that period.

We look forward to sharing more information with you shortly.
