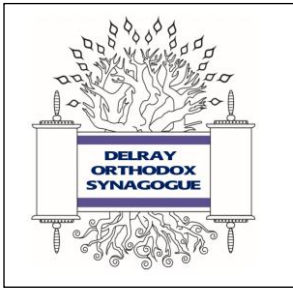

## RABBI'S MESSAGE

Ahhh and breathe. So after  
delivering 12 sermons, four  
shiurim and making four hospital  
visits I can finally lift my head  
above the water. I would like to  
pay immense tribute to my wife  
and extend a debt of gratitude as  
it has not been easy moving two  
days before Rosh Hashanah,  
having to deal with all the yomim  
tovim and having a three month  
old baby, plus a 4 year old!. It felt  
like we were thrown into the deep  
end of the pool and I would like  
to thank all those who helped  
make this transition as easy as  
possible for us.

I have really enjoyed this holiday  
season and hope the  
congregation has too. I hope  
Hashem will answer all our  
prayers just like He did as soon  
as we said Geshem ( the prayer  
for rain). For those of you who  
were not in shul, it started to pour  
with rain as soon as we started  
the prayer.

However, there is no rest for the  
weary (and the not so wicked).  
For no sooner have we just  
completed the Torah we start  
again. The Jewish cycle is never-  
ending and as I said in my last  
sermon: "The holiday season  
may be over but we need to  
make sure we are in the play-  
offs, the post season". It is the  
longest possible time until the  
next holiday which is Passover,  
as it is a leap year(Adar I & II)  
and both the months of  
Cheshvan and Kislev have 30  
days.

By rededicating ourselves to the  
Torah and trying to study that  
little bit more, we will hopefully  
merit to make it all the way to the  
Super Bowl game and keep our  
connection with Hashem as  
stronger than ever.

We have now commenced  
saying 'MASHIV HA'RUACH  
U'MORID HA'GESHEM' in the  
second Bracha of the Amidah . If  
one omits this, they need to  
repeat the entire Amidah.
