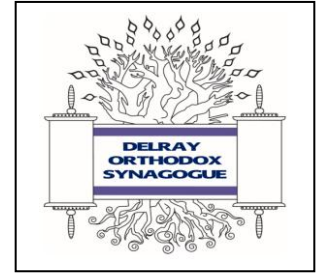

RABBI'S MESSAGE

2448 years after the creation of the world, Hashem finally gave us some Mitzvos with which to serve and please him. The first was the commandment to sanctify the new moon followed swiftly by the laws of the Korban Pesach and the laws pertaining to Pesach. The Parsha finishes off with the laws of Tefillin. I would like to go over some of the laws of tefillin to refresh peoples' memory.

The Tefillin Shel Yad (Arm) should be worn on the bicep of the 'weaker' arm. They should be placed on the downward slope of the bicep. A good rule is to bend your elbow and place 2 fingers on your arm. At the point where your fingers end is where the Tefillin should be placed. They should be tilted slightly inward towards the heart but must still be on the bicep. Many people place their tefillin on the side of their arm which is invalid. When your arm rests by your body with the palm of your hand facing forwards, the right side (or left side) outer edge of the Tefillin should be up against your body.

The Tefillin Shel Rosh (Head) should be placed on the hair (or where your hair used to be) in between the eyes. The knot at the back should be on the bone at the back of your head. Many people have the knot placed far too low and we should make a special effort to make sure we have our Tefillin adjusted correctly.

The mitzvah of Tefillin is the equivalent of learning the whole Torah, as the verse says: "the tefillin are worn in order that Hashem's Torah should be in your mouth". Many commentators including the famous halachic commentator the 'ROSH' say that this is the most important of all the 248 positive commandments.
