

Five months ago after a thyroidectomy my voice was stilled. I realized then how important it is to have the power of speech. At that time I had trouble breathing, eating, swallowing, drinking liquids- and how I just wanted to be able to drink a glass of water! So that became my goal. After 3 months I could swallow water and other liquids which buoyed my spirits. Doctors' diagnoses were pessimistic so I was resigned to have to whisper, but tried to keep my hopes up. When you don't have a voice, life becomes more of a struggle. You cannot make appointments over the phone, you cannot be heard in a noisy area, you get rejected in a store because you cannot be heard etc. etc. But still I remained hopeful and reverted to my listening to music. A few weeks ago I travelled to Israel to visit with my daughter and my wonderful grandchildren for rest and to restore my energy. Upon my return, I went to the throat specialist that I had seen on a prior occasion and after his pessimistic view of my throat, he suddenly saw movement of one of my paralyzed vocal chords. We were all so elated upon hearing my voice after 5 months. My immediate reaction was to thank Hashem for giving me courage to face the adversity, for my wonderful family and friends who kept encouraging me at all times. I believe that all these prayers were answered last Friday. And now I raise my voice in gratitude. "Kol Rina Vi-yeshua"

RABBI'S MESSAGE

We are over half way through Chanukah, festival of lights, which not only commemorates the miracle of the Menorah burning for 8 days, but our victory over Hellenism. The Greeks' main goal was not against the Jews as a people. After all, they allowed us to live in their empire. Instead, they forbade us from living and studying our holy Torah. They knew that if we stopped keeping the Torah, eventually we would cease being Jewish. This was a very clever trap. Ultimately, our demise would have been a product of our own, seemingly voluntary, assimilation.

This is why I believe Hashem expressed the miracle through an extension in time. King Solomon analogizes the light of the Menorah to Torah (Proverbs 6:23). Therefore, by causing the miracle of the prolonged Menorah light, Hashem was telling us that we need to prolong the light of Torah. This is why it's such a jolly time of year. We must realise the gem that we have been given and its ability to make us happy. We need to try and keep more Torah and let its light shine brightly before us, illuminating the correct and holy path through the dark and confusing maze of life.

What is the origin of the dreidel? In times of persecution when Torah study was forbidden, Jewish children would learn anyway. When soldiers would investigate, the children would pull out a dreidel and pretend to be playing. The letters on the dreidel are nun, gimmel, hey, shin — the first letters of Nes Gadol Haya Sham — "A Great Miracle Happened There." One way to play dreidel is to see who can keep their spinning for the longest time. Or alternatively, to see how many dreidels you can get spinning simultaneously. Another version of dreidel is where players use pennies, nuts, raisins, or chocolate coins as tokens or chips. Each player puts an equal share into the "pot." The first player takes a turn spinning the dreidel. When the dreidel stops, the letter facing up determines:

- Nun — nothing happens; the next player spins the dreidel
- Gimmel — the spinner takes the pot

- Hey — take half the pot
- Shin — add one to the pot
