RABBI'S MESSAGE

I would like to take this opportunity in my first article as the Rabbi of DOS to wish everyone a happy and healthy new year, full of good health and happiness, free from all trouble and sorrow. By the time you read this my family and I should be settled in an apartment in Murano. We are moving in before Shabbat, ready and excited to start our new role in the community. We are so overwhelmed by the kind wishes and offers of help and hospitality that we received especially before we knew if we would get our own apartment before the holidays. We only completed the lease on Tuesday (yes, 3 days ago) and got rushed approval from Murano after jumping through lots of hoops. I even got permission to erect a Succah. The offers of hospitality took the pressure off us and helped to calm our frayed nerves. My wife and I would like to thank everyone from the bottom of our hearts. We have been made to feel most welcome and we can't wait to lead the community into the exciting future that awaits.

As we look forward to the High Holidays, we should remember that we owe G-d absolutely everything. We are like newborn babies who cannot do anything for themselves. Without G-d's help we would be powerless. He gives us our souls back each morning and provides us with all our needs and desires.

We all should feel a sense of gratitude to Hashem that should

make us want to do something for Him.

We should all strive do at least the easy Mitzvot like men wearing Tzitzit which are inexpensive and go under our shirts, so nobody knows we are wearing them. This means we are doing a Mitzvah every second of daylight hours. We should all make a Succah, or at least come and use the Shuls Succah and certainly all purchase a Lulov and Esrog.

I hope to be able to host some communal meals in the Shul Succah to accommodate those people who are not allowed to make a succah at home. Each person can find that one extra Mitzvah they can add to their collection this year. Even something like coming to shul an extra time during the week. If we want Hashem to grant us life then we need to use our lives to serve Him and do things for other people. Asseret Y'Mai Teshuvah (From RH through YK)

We substitute the ending of the 11th Berachah of the Amidah to 'Hamelech Hamishpat'. If omitted do not repeat the Amidah.
