RABBI'S MESSAGE

This week we learn about the religious police. I know I said in my video that I wasn't the religious police, but the concept certainly exists. We are told to appoint judges in every city and police to enforce those judgements. They would act the same way as a modern day police force does. But before you start getting scared, this mitzvah no longer applies. The chain of judges being appointed directly from Moshe Rabbeinu was broken during the Roman rule of Israel at the time of the destruction of the second Temple. Therefore, we no longer have Sanhedrin judges today. No judges means no religious police. We cannot adjudicate capital cases or give lashes. The 'Dayanim' that we have today in a modern day Beth Din mostly use compromise to reach a fair decision.

We also have the mitzvah of appointing a king. A king has complete and total power and can put anyone to death. This is the rationale that King Saul used when chasing King David. He reasoned that David had rebelled against his Kingdom and he and all those who helped him were liable to the death penalty. The reality was David had done no such thing and it was only King Saul's jealousy towards David for defeating Goliath. We read about the mitzvah of listening to a prophet and the punishment for disobeying.

The army conscription requirements are delineated and only the most G-d fearing sinless people would be approved. Those who were worried about sins they had committed were excused for fear of being slain on account of those sins.

People who build a new house or vineyard, acquired a wife or who just didn't have the stomach for the fight were sent home.

The Parsha concludes with the story of the strangled calf in the valley. If somebody was found murdered between two cities, a young calf was killed to atone for the murderous sin. The elders of the nearest city had to come out and declare that they never killed this person. Rashi raises the point, do we really suspect the elders of committing murder? He answers that they had to declare that they didn't let the victim visit or depart without proper provisions. They declared that they did everything possible to make this person feel welcome in the village whilst he was there. From here we deduce a frightening lesson. Not looking after somebody well enough, not making sure people have exactly what they need is tantamount to murder. It is imperative that we all make sure that all members of the community are looked after in whatever they need. Whether that be financial or medical or anything else. As

the Book of Life is being dusted off in Heaven in preparation for Rosh Hashana, let's make sure we undertake to improve the lives of those around us. In this merit may we be inscribed in the Book of Life for a Happy and Healthy New Year.
