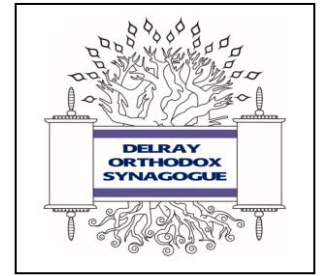

RABBI'S MESSAGE

In this week's Parsha, we read about Yaakov becoming ill. The Midrash says that Yaakov was the first person to become ill in the history of the world. Until then, people just sneezed and expired hence the phrase "bless you" after somebody sneezes. However, people would get very shocked when their loved ones just died without giving them time to say goodbye (or indeed time to issue allocations of their estate). So to remedy this Yaakov prayed that people get ill prior to passing away.

Yaakov therefore took this opportunity to bless all his children. He wanted to reveal the date for the coming of Moshiach, but Hashem hid it from him. Can you imagine the anguish the Jews at the time of the destruction of the Temple would have felt if they knew that he would not come for another at least 1951 years. Therefore, this information is best left to our imagination. We have to believe that any moment, even now as I write this message, or if Moshiach didn't come and this has now been printed and you are reading it in shul, he can come right now before you finish reading it.

The parsha finishes with Yaakov's death and his subsequent funeral procession to Israel. He was buried with a lot of honour but his children still returned to Egypt where things would never be the same again. According to many sources, the remaining five years of famine predicted in Paroah's dream, returned to haunt Egypt. According to some opinions, the famine in the land of Egypt stopped when Yaakov came there.
