This week is the worldwide 'Shabbat Project'. This was an initiative started by Rabbi Goldstein, Chief Rabbi of South Africa to encourage people to at least keep one Shabbat. The Talmud tells us if all the Jewish people would keep one Shabbos, Moshiach would come. Some Shuls have Challah bakes and some have Special lectures about keeping Shabbat. Even people who keep Shabbat are encouraged to do something special in honor of the special occasion. At the conclusion of Shabbat many Shuls have a havdalah party to celebrate people keeping Shabbat.
