

## RABBI'S MESSAGE

This week we learn about our patriarch Yaakov. Eisav wanted to kill Yaakov after he deceived him over Yitzchak's blessings. Yaakov runs off to his uncle Lavan. He turns up in Choron and meets a beautiful girl (Rachel) by the well. He immediately knows that this is the wife for him. He gets so excited that he removes a massive boulder from the well all by himself.

He then goes to meet her father (Lavan) and agreed to work for seven years in order to marry his daughter, Rachel. After seven years he is deceived by his father-in-law and ends up marrying her sister, Leah. (and people make mother-in-law jokes!) He then agreed to work another seven years and married Rachel straightaway. He then had 12 sons and one daughter.

After a total of 20 years – Hashem finally tells him to go back home to his father. He runs off while Lavan is away at a sheepling convention. Lavan hears the news and chases after him and tries to kill him but in the end an armistice is reached.

It is very interesting to note that when Yaakov initially turns up at Choron, he scolds the workers for leaving early and finishing their work before sunset. They reply to him they are not "bunking off" but rather waiting for everybody to come to remove the boulder from on top of the well. The question is: if this were to happen nowadays most people would tell the guy to (and I'll paraphrase) 'please stop talking and move away'. So why did the shepherds answer Yaakov so respectfully? The answer is he used the word 'my brothers' i.e., he asked them in a nice way, in a gentle way, out of friendship. This is how we can get results in the world by being nice and gentle and not aggressive and angry. This is the whole premise to the book 'How to win friends and influence people'. We can achieve more by

asking in a nice friendly way than by barking out orders.
