## RABBI'S MESSAGE

This week we read about the life of our patriarch Avram. As we all know, Avram underwent 10 tests and passed them all with flying colors. Of course like everything in Judaism there is a difference of opinion exactly what those 10 tests were. However, the majority of them are in this week's Parsha.

These tests included:

\*Being thrown into the fire by King Nimrod

\*Having to leave his home at the age of 75 to travel to new pastures

\*Having his wife Sarah taken away on two separate occasions

\*Being greeted on his arrival to his new country by a famine and having to leave right away

\*Going to war to save his nephew

\*Offering his son as a sacrifice

\*Seeing the troubles that will befall his children in Egypt

\*Sending away his other son Yishmael

\*Circumcising himself at the age of 99.

I would like to get peoples perspective on which test they feel was the hardest for Avraham to pass. The obvious one is offering his son as a sacrifice, but then again this practice was rife amongst pagan people. Perhaps having to leave his home town at the age of 75. Snowbirds know how difficult travel can be. I myself know what it is like to give up being a rabbi, moving to somewhere new and being a total stranger in a foreign

land. Nobody knows you, or even cares what you have done in the past. You have to start all over again. Perhaps coming to Israel and seeing a famine and having to leave without questioning Hashem. Please let me have your opinions.
