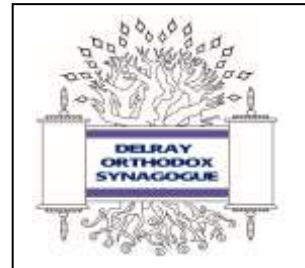

**RABBI'S MESSAGE**

I would like to take this opportunity to wish everyone a Happy and Healthy New Year full of good health and happiness free from all trouble and sorrow and Coronavirus.

This year has been a difficult year. I am sure we have all known people who have passed away and not been able to attend their funerals in person. The coronavirus pandemic of 2019/20 has meant we have had to attend funerals on zoom. Our shul live streamed the funeral of Marilyn Finkel which I officiated at. It was a surreal experience. Surveying the pews with a few socially distanced family members present whilst speaking into an iPad. We even had a eulogy via zoom. People have found it difficult not being able to say their proper goodbyes and pay their respects to the deceased and to the mourners. Our shul has been closed for 6 months although we will be IYH opening for Sukkot. We daven outside Mincha and Maariv in the heat and humidity.

This year alone we saw the many ways which G-d can kill a person. We say in the famous 'Unesaneh Tokef' prayer: 'Who will be killed by plague' - needs no explanation this year, 'Who will be killed by the storm' - we are currently having a record breaking hurricane season which even came up north.

“Who by starving” - Look at the shortage of food due to the pandemic.

'Who will be rich and who will lose everything' - how many industries have been decimated. No one could have predicted the cruise and leisure industry collapsing.

As we look forward to the High Holidays, we should remember that we owe G-d for absolutely everything. We are like newborn babies who cannot do anything for themselves. Without G-ds' help we would be powerless. He gives us our souls back each morning and provides us with all our needs and desires. In-fact, as many have suffered with the coronavirus this year, we need to be especially thankful that we are alive and well.
