THE REBUILDING PROJECT

So the infamous gentile prophet Bilaam is hired by King Balak to curse the entire Jewish nation. On his journey to see the king, the donkey that Bilaam's riding on unexpectedly veers off the road. So Bilaam hits it to get it back on the path. Then it does it again, so Bilaam hits it again. Then a third time, the donkey suddenly crouches down and doesn't budge. Bilaam is enraged and starts beating the donkey.

To Bilaam, it would seem that the donkey has lost its mind... It's acting totally out of character. None of it makes any sense.

Shortly after this, Hashem "opens Bilaam's eyes", and he sees an angel standing in the road holding a sword in his hand. The angel explains to Bilaam that he had been blocking the road all along, that's why the donkey kept turning aside.

So, is Bilaam still angry at the donkey? No. His anger has vanished because he has CLARITY... Now it makes sense.

Isn't it amazing how seeing the bigger picture can immediately defuse our anger. We yearn to make sense of our world. We're wired to want to understand why things are the way they are, and why they're not the way we want them to be. And this is especially true when dealing with other people. Think how often we get angry at someone simply because we can't figure out why they are the way they are! "Why are they so negative? Or so abrasive? Or always park their car crooked? Or exaggerate so much... It's not just the behavior we don't care for, it's the great mystery of why they aren't more the way we want them to be! We crave to understand the WHY? (Just like Bilaam.)

But we of course can't count on Hashem to send us an angel to reveal the bigger picture. So what do we do? Well, we can unwisely double down and prolong our futile quest to know WHY... or, we can say "goodbye to asking why," and turn our futility into humility. When we ACCEPT that we will never have all the answers, it's a huge weight off our shoulders. And it also becomes easier to ACCEPT and deal with the other person's irritating behavior. Which over time, often stops being so irritating...

Unlike Bilaam, we may not have the clarity that comes from knowing "WHY". But we can gain something even greater-- the clarity that comes from understanding that it's okay NOT to know why.
