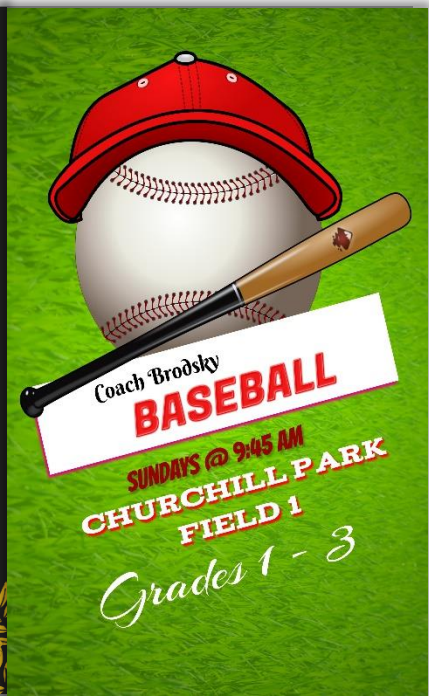

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THE REBUILDING PROJECT

You often hear people say that you gotta dream big. But sometimes if you dream small, the results can be enormous.

In his book, *Love Your Neighbor*, Rabbi Zelig Pliskin shares the following inspirational anecdote: “The sons of Rabbi Avraham Grodzinski wrote that their father worked for two years on acquiring a pleasant facial expression. This became so ingrained in his character that even during the darkest and gloomiest days of the Second World War when he and his family were incarcerated in the Ghetto of Slobodka and their lives were in constant danger, his outward expression was always cheerful.” (Toras Avraham, p.11)

This great rabbi worked on having a pleasant cheerful expression for TWO YEARS! And he was successful! Can you imagine the impact that had on his family and everyone he came in contact with? Not just the good will that his smile conveyed, but think about the people who had known him for years before this. They might’ve thought, “Wow, he used to have such a serious face! He looks so happy now!” What an inspiration that must’ve been for people to constantly see! And what a ray of hope when incarcerated in the Ghetto.

What small, but potentially huge thing can this story inspire us to achieve? It’s exciting to think of the possibilities! Maybe having a more pleasant facial expression is something you also want to work on. If so, go for it! Or maybe you want to work on telling a family member “I love you” one more time a day every single day. I don’t know...could be anything. Choose something that speaks to you and gets you excited and then go for it.

Let’s use Rabbi Grodzinski’s amazing feat to inspire us to dream small. The results can be life changing. And the life you change will likely, not just be your own.
