For individuals who follow *Zmanim* of the *Magen Avraham*,
the times are 10:52am and 12:07pm respectively.

Curtail Food Intake as of: 4:30pm

Prepare for second night candle lighting by lighting a *Yahrzeit* candle (48 hours) from which to transfer flame.

During the day, make *Eruv Tavshilin*.

Candle Lighting: Earliest 6:23pm*; Standard 7:23pm*
Conclude Mincha no later than: 7:42pm
Recommended time for Ma'ariv: 8:00pm
Earliest Time for Seder Kiddush: 8:16pm
Eat Afikoman by "Chazot" 1:23am

THURSDAY, APRIL 9, FIRST DAY PESACH

Shacharit recommended times: 8, 9, & 9:30am

In *Musaf* omit *Mashiv HaRuach u'Morid HaGeshem* (It is advisable to say *Morid HaTal* on 1st day *Musaf* then resume regular custom as of *Mincha*. Those who *daven Nusach Sefard* or *Adut HaMizrach* begin to recite *Morid HaTal*)

Latest Shema: 10:12am
Counting of the Omer: Day 1
Conclude Mincha by: 7:42pm
Recommended time for Ma'ariv: 8:10pm
Candle Lighting: Not before 8:18*

*When lighting candles on the second night of *Yom Tov*, the flame should be transferred from an existing flame. (Reminder: Earliest time to begin preparations for the second Seder is following Candle Lighting at 8:18pm.)

FRIDAY, APRIL 10, SECOND DAY PESACH

Latest Shema: 10:11am
Recommended Mincha: 6:15 & 7:30pm
Conclude Mincha by: 7:43pm

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 15, SEVENTH DAY PESACH

Shacharit recommended times: 7:30, 8:30, & 9:00am
Latest Shema: 10:08am
Recommended Mincha: 6:15 & 7:30pm
Conclude Mincha by: 7:45pm
Candle Lighting: Not before 8:26*

* When lighting candles on the second night of *Yom Tov*, the flame should be transferred from an existing flame. It is advisable to light a 48-hour *Yahrzeit* candle on *Erev Yom Tov* for this purpose.

THURSDAY, APRIL 16, EIGHTH DAY PESACH

Shacharit recommended times: 7:30, 8:30, & 9:00am
Latest Shema: 10:08am
Yom Tov Ends: 8:21pm
Chametz Available: 9:05pm

EARLIEST TIME FOR CONSUMING SOLD CHAMETZ

After *Pesach* is over, the earliest time for consuming *Chametz* that was sold by Rabbi Yasgur is 9:05pm on *Thursday*, April 16.
