Earliest with bracha 6:29 pm
Standard 7:33 pm

CANDLE LIGHTING NOTE – When one household member is attending an early Minyan and another is lighting at home, it is preferable to light before the Shul attendee returns home (about 7:05 pm this week). Regular candle lighting time on April 28th is 7:33 pm. The earliest time to light candles with a bracha is 6:29 pm this week. One leaving for Shul with no one else at home to light candles may light before 6:29 pm, but should not recite the bracha. Alternatively, one may ask a Jewish neighbor to light his candles between 6:29 pm and Shekia (Sunset).
