Regular candle lighting time on April 28th is 7:33 pm. The earliest time to light candles with a bracha is 6:29 pm this week. One leaving for Shul with no one else at home to light candles may light before 6:29 pm, but should not recite the bracha. Alternatively, one may ask a
