CANDLE LIGHTING NOTE – When one household member is attending an early Minyan and another is lighting at home, it is preferable to light before the Shul attendee returns home (about 7:25 pm this week). Regular candle lighting time on July 21st is 7:55 pm.

The earliest time to light candles with a bracha is 6:49 pm this week. One leaving for Shul with no one else at home to light candles may light before 6:49 pm, but should not recite the bracha. Alternatively, one may ask a Jewish neighbor to light his candles between 6:49 pm and Shekia (Sunset).
