PARASHAT KI TAVO SHABBAT TIMES **Candle Lighting** 

Earliest with bracha 6:21 pm 7:22 pm Standard CANDLE LIGHTING NOTE – When one household member is attending an early Minyan and another is lighting at home, it is preferable to light before the Shul attendee returns home (about 6:55 pm this week).

The earliest time to light candles with a bracha is 6:21 pm this week. One leaving for Shul with no one else at home to light candles may light before 6:21 pm, but should not recite the bracha. Alternatively, one may ask a Jewish neighbor to light his candles between 6:21 pm and Shekia (Sunset).


