Friday, April 19 is the last day to have chametz in the Shul building.*

If you are expecting guests with children for Shabbat Hagadol, and some of the children will need a snack, please be certain that all snacks are Kosher for Passover.

If you have a Shul locker, please empty it of any Chametz by April 19. If you have any other possessions in Shul (a Talit bag, Shabbat purse, etc.), please check these for Chametz, as well.

*Exceptions are Food for Catered Shabbat HaGadol Meals, Seudah Shelisheet on Parashat Metzora, and Chametz owned by the Shul (including its official branches)

and designated to be sold to a non-Jew.
