CANDLE LIGHTING NOTE – When one household member is attending an early *Minyan* and another is lighting at home, it is preferable to light before the *Shul* attendee returns home (about 7:30 pm this week). Regular candle lighting time on July 1st is 7:59 pm. The earliest time to light candles with a *bracha* is 6:51 pm this week. One leaving for *Shul* with no one else at home to light candles, **may light before 6:51 pm, but should** <u>not</u> recite the *bracha*. Alternately, one may ask a Jewish neighbor to light his candles after 6:51.
