Riddle

Question: The Torah specifies in Parshat Shelach (15:3-11) that a Minchat Nesachim (flour, oil and a wine libation) be brought together with every animal (not bird) korban Olah or Shelamim, whether from an individual or the tzibbur. Who is the only person who brings a Minchat Nesachim with a korban Asham and a korban Chatat?

Last Week's Riddle

Question: : A category of matza permitted for Pesach (other than shemura) is "18-minute matza." Since even non-18 minute matza may be certified kosher for Pesach, what is the significance of the 18 minutes?

Answer: 18-minute matza means that the baking implements (conveyor belts, oven, utensils, etc.) are cleaned every 18 minutes to eliminate any residue, lest it become chametz. It is an extra precaution.






Please note that the speed-bump will be re-installed at the end of the driveway on April 7th as a reminder to continue to drive slowly when entering, exiting and driving on shul property.


