#### Riddle

**Question:** We read Kohellet, Shir HaShirim and Rut on Shabbat Yom Tov BEFORE laining the Torah, yet we read Megillat Esther AFTER reading the Torah on Purim morning. Why?

#### Last Week's Riddle

**Question:** : Fourteen of the characters mentioned in Megillat Esther were either executed or assassinated, and possibly a fifteenth (it is questionable). Can you name them?

**Answer:** Haman and his ten sons, Bigtan and Teresh were all executed. King Achashverosh (= Xerxes) was assassinated by his eldest son (or a courtier aided by his son) in 465 BCE. The questionable one is Vashti.


