Last Week's Riddle

Question: : We read Kohellet, Shir HaShirim and Rut on Shabbat Yom Tov BEFORE laining the Torah, yet we read Megillat Esther AFTER reading the Torah on Purim morning. Why?

Answer: The Rabbis prohibited learning Ketuvim on Shabbat between Shacharit and Mincha to encourage learning Halacha (after Mincha is the reverse). The three cited Megillot in Ketuvim are read before the end of Shacharit (=laining). Esther is never read on Shabbat, so we invoke tadir v'she'eino tadir (the more regular one (laining) goes first).
