## Riddle

**Question:** The long paragraph beginning with "Shome'a adecha ..." that we say at the beginning of Selichot (not counting Ashrei) functions as shevach (praise) of Hashem, which is required before asking for mercy and selicha in the 13 Middot and in the Viddui. It is also said in Selichot on Kol Nidrei night, but NOT at Ne'ila (nor in Shacharit, Mussaf and Mincha of Yom Kippur for those who say Selichot then). Why not?

Last Week's Riddle:

**Question:** We begin Selichot with "Ashrei" (mostly Tehillim 145). There is a clear thematic connection between one pasuk in that chapter and the central refrain of Selichot. What pasuk is it?

**Answer:** The "chet" verse ("Chanun v'rachum Hashem, erech apayim u'gdol chesed") parallels the 13 Middot of Hashem, the key portion of Selichot.

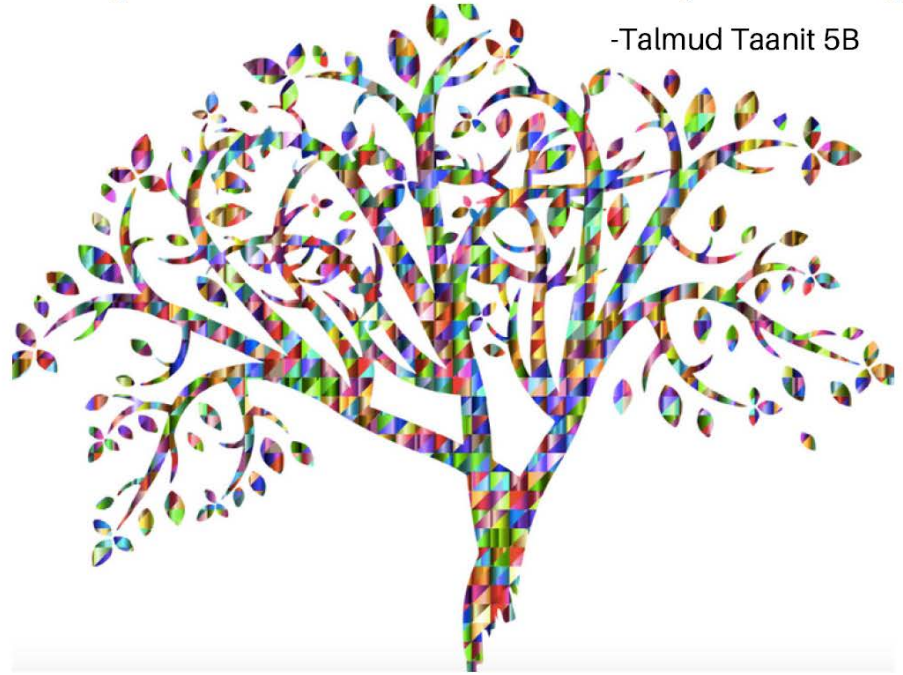

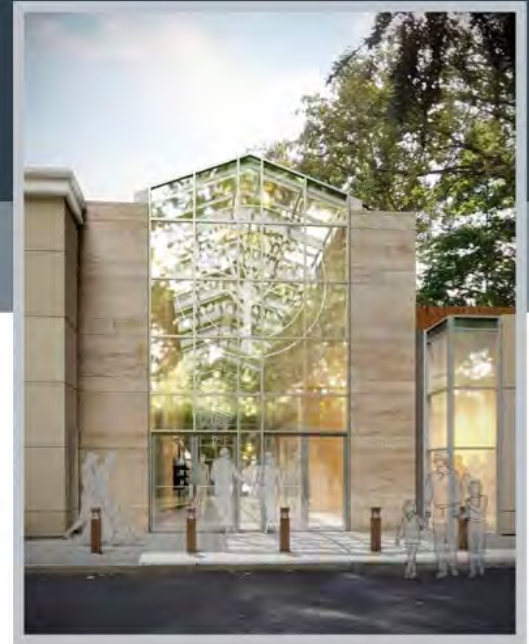
