בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יהוּה אֱלֹהִינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתִיוּ, וְצִוְּנוּ עַל נְטִילַת יָדְיִם.

Baruch attah Adonai Eloheinu melech ha'olam asher kiddishanu b'mitzvotav v'tsivvanu al netilat yadayim. Blessed are you God our Lord, King of the world, who has sanctified us with his commandments, and has commanded us with regard to the taking (washing) of the hands.

Procedure:

- 1. Wash your hands normally. (Ritual handwashing is not about cleanliness, it is ritual purification).
- 2. Fill washing cup with water with your non-dominant hand.
- 3. With your non-dominant hand, pour water over your dominant hand (up to the wrist) twice.
- 4. Pass the cup to your dominant hand.
- 5. With your dominant hand, pour water over your non-dominant hand (up to the wrist) twice.
- 6. While holding your hands in front of you, say the blessing.
- 7. Completely dry your hands with a clean towel.
- 8. Say silent until you make the blessing for bread and swallow, or go on with your day.
