JENNIFER GRANHOLM**  
GOVERNOR OF MICHIGAN 2003-2011

Governor Jennifer M. Granholm served two terms as governor of Michigan.

Part of Granholm's strategy for Michigan's economic revival after the auto industry bankruptcies included leading an investment mission to Israel. She signed an MOU between Michigan and Israel – focusing on energy efficiency and technology – making Michigan the first U.S. state to sign a water technology agreement with Israel.

Granholm is a managing partner of Ridge-Lane LP, teaches policy and is a senior research fellow at the University of California, Berkeley, and is a member of the advisory board at the University of Chicago's Institute of Politics. Granholm is a senior political contributor to CNN, a senior advisor to Media Matters for America, and the chair of the American Bridge Foundation. She is an honors graduate of UC Berkeley and Harvard Law School and has travelled to Israel four times, most recently with the American Israel Education Foundation, AIPAC's affiliated charitable organization.
