CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION YOUNG ISRAEL SYNAGOGUE OF BORO PARK, INC.

33402-M Pursuant to Article 10 of the Religious Corporation Law.

WE, the undersigned, all being persons of full age. of whom at least two-thirds are citizens of the United States. and all being residents of the State of New York, for the purpose of incorporating an uninforporated Jewish synagogue, pursuant to Article 10 of the Religious Corporation Law, hereby certify as follows:

- 1. A meeting of Young Israel Synagogue of Boro Park, an unincorporated Jewish synagogue, was duly called and held in conformity with the aforesaid article of the Religious Corporation Law at 1363 - 50th Street, Brooklyn, New York, on the 9th day of Sept.,1952, at which meeting a majority of the duly qualified voters of said synagogue, being at least six in number, were present.
- 2. At said meeting, Abraham S. Bodoff, one of the subscribers hereto, was presiding officer, and Joseph Appleman and Max Feiner, the other subscribers hereto, were present and voted thereat.
- 3. At said meeting it was duly decided that said synagogue should become incorporated.
- 4. The name of the proposed corporation, as decided on at said meeting, is to be YOUNG ISRAEL SYNAGOGUE OF BORO PARK, INC.
  - 5. The number of trustees thereof shall be mix.
- 6. The names of the persons elected as trustees, and the terms of office for which they were respectively elected are as follows:

JULIUS EIDELMAN and AARON KRUMBEIN, to hold office until the first annual election of trustees thereafter;

LOUIS BLAU and MEYER DREYER, to hold office until the second annual election of trustees thereafter; and

SIDNEY DRESSLER and MARTIN LILKER, to hold office until the third annual election thereafter.

- 7. The first annual election of the Trustees shall be held on the 3rd day of April, 1953, and the annual election of trustees shall each year thereafter be held on said 3rd day of April.
- 8. The principal place of worship of said synagogue is located in the Borough of Brooklyn, County of Kings, City and State of New York.
