SIMCHAT TORAH FAQ

Obviously, Simchat Torah is going to look very differently this year. Please see Rabbi Brander's note about these changes in our Eblast. On a practical level, here is what we are planning for Simchat Torah:

- All attendees must sign up before Yom Tov. (If the minyan is full, please put your name on the waiting list)
- Hakafot will be made by the Chazan holding a single Torah. Everyone else will be asked to stay in their places.
- We will sing a song for each hakafah interspersed with words of Torah from different members.
- We will be having a regular Torah reading and NOT giving all men aliyot.
- We will be reading Kohelet between Mincha Maativ in between the 1st and 2nd day instead of at Shacharit.
- Kol HaNe'arim will take place in the AFTERNOON at the completion of our Youth Scavenger hunt at approximately 4:10. We will NOT be using the big tallit this year. Each family may bring their own tallit to put over their children's heads for Kol HaNe'arim -- it is not necessary.
