Simchat Torah 5782/2021 FAQ

With the continued monitoring of Covid-19, Simchat Torah this year will have a few changes we wanted you to be aware of:

- Hakafot will be shortened.
- After each Hakafa there we will be a Dvrei Torah.
- There will be a Torah both on the Men's and Women's Side.
- The Torah will be held by one person and not passed around from person to person.
- We ask that you please refrain from kissing the Torah
