Shannon Sarna

Shannon Sarna is founding editor of *The Nosh*, the widest-reaching website dedicated to Jewish food, which is part of the 70 Faces Media group. Shannon grew up in upstate New York immersed in performance and music as well as surrounded by diverse culinary experiences: Her Sicilian American mother loved to bake, her Ashkenazi Jewish father loved to experiment, and her grandfather was a food chemist who patented Tang, among other products. Her writing and recipes have been featured in *Bake from Scratch Magazine*, *Taste of Home Magazine*, *Parade Magazine*, *Food52*, *The Kitchn*, *Tablet Magazine*, *JTA News*, *New Jersey Monthly Magazine* Vinepair, and *Modern Loss*. Her first cookbook, *Modern Jewish Comfort Food: Challah, Babka, Bagels & More*, was released in September 2017 by Countryman Press.

100 Fresh Recipes for Classic Dishes from Kugel to Kreplach

Comfort food varies from person to person, family to family, region to region. As the author of *Modern Jewish Baker* and editor of *The Nosh*, Shannon Sarna has always wanted to tell the story of the Jewish people through food and continues to do so here in her latest book. *Modern Jewish Comfort Food* showcases recipes and variations that have shaped Jewish cuisine from around the world—including immigration waves from Europe, the Middle East, North Africa, New York City, and beyond. Sarna shares many traditional dishes, and then provides exciting variations to cleverly interpret tomato & pepper shakshuka into a deep-dish pizza; classic potato latkes invite vegetable-focused variations such as beet & carrot and summer corn zucchini; and a multitude of dumplings reflect the range of the Jewish diaspora. Sweets includes two kinds of Israeli-style yeasted rugelach, funfetti macaroons, and more—ready to complete the holiday dessert table. *Modern Jewish Comfort Food* will inspire home cooks to connect to Jewish foodways and explore the history of this diverse cuisine.
