Alden Solovy

This Precious Life

Encountering the Divine with Poetry and Prayer

Alden Solovy is a liturgist, author, journalist, and educator. He has written more than seven hundred pieces of new liturgy, offering a fresh new Jewish voice that challenges the boundaries between poetry, meditation, and prayer. Solovy has taught around the world, including at HUC-JIR and Pardes Institute in Jerusalem, Limmud and Leo Baeck College in the UK, and at dozens of synagogues throughout North America.

In *This Precious Life*, the third book in a trilogy, liturgist Alden Solovy presents prayers, poetry, and meditations inspired by encounters with God. The first part draws from divine moments in our sacred texts, mostly the Torah but also the Prophets and the Writings. Using a contemporary voice, Solovy imagines these holy moments as experienced by our biblical ancestors so we can reclaim them as our own. The second part focuses on sacred moments in our daily lives, connections with the Divine that occur simply because we are human beings created in God's image. Equally suited to individual reflection and group prayer, *This Precious Life* completes a trilogy with *This Grateful Heart* and *This Joyous Soul*.

Robert Lefkowitz, M.D. with Randy Hall

A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to Stockholm
The Adrenaline-Fueled Adventures of an Accidental Scientist

Robert J. Lefkowitz is a Nobel Prize-winning scientist (Chemistry, 2012) who is best known for showing how adrenaline works via stimulation of specific receptors. He was trained at Columbia, the NIH and Harvard before joining the faculty at Duke University and becoming an Investigator of the Howard Hughes Medical Institute. In addition to being a researcher, Dr. Lefkowitz is a cardiologist as well as a cardiac patient.

Randy Hall was a post-doctoral trainee of Dr. Lefkowitz in the 1990's and is now a Professor in the Emory University School of Medicine. He has published more than one hundred scientific papers and received major awards for his research. He is also a prize-winning educator with strong interests in science writing and public outreach about science and medicine.

A self-described "accidental scientist," Dr. Robert Lefkowitz was inspired to study medicine at age 12 when his father suffered a heart attack; by age 19, he had graduated from college and begun medical school. Lefkowitz recounts a pivotal lesson he learned in his third-year — "Data are just data. A story is something you impose on the data" — and how it came to inform the way he practiced medicine: closely listening to his patients' stories became his hallmark. After medical school, Lefkowitz joined the faculty at Duke, where he mentored Brian Kobilka; their work on DNA proteins won them the Nobel Prize. He and Kobilka were "treated like rock stars" during the weeklong Nobel celebration, of which he notes: "There is nothing in the United States that compares to the Nobel Day events in Sweden." This vivid memoir shines with personality. Rarely has science been treated with such a winning blend of humor and humanity.

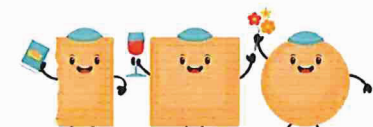
