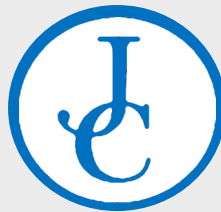

THE JEWISH CENTER'S ONE GIFT PROGRAM

The Jewish Center launched a new membership program, *One Gift*, in 2015. *One Gift* enables those members who are interested in giving a set amount each year, to commit to that contribution at the beginning of the year.

There are several benefits of the *One Gift* program. For our *One Gift* members, the program provides a desired level of convenience and clarity by eliminating the need to make multiple gifts to the synagogue over the course of the year. The benefits for The Jewish Center cannot be understated. Foremost, the upfront commitments from our members provide the synagogue with a degree of financial certainty and security that is critically important. In addition, *One Gift* reduces the drain on our volunteers who no longer need (and in fact are prohibited!) from calling our *One Gift* members for sponsorships.

The *One Gift* program is not mandatory. We know that many members prefer to make separate gifts throughout the year and we invite those members to continue to do so.
