

Shacharit and Musaf for Rosh Hashanah 5781 at Home

We will miss davening with you at The Jewish Center this year. We hope that this will help guide you through the Machzor on Rosh HaShanah from your home.

When davening without a minyan, one **omits Barchu, Kaddish, Kedushah, and Chazarat HaShatz**. There are many beautiful *piyyutim* throughout Rosh HaShanah davening that you may want to include. Many of the classic *piyyutim* are found in *Chazarat HaShatz*, so we have noted below a few of the prominent ones that you can recite after your Amidah for Shacharit and Musaf.

You omit the Torah service, but you can read through both the Torah and Haftarah readings.
