Torah on Tour

The Zakef-Katon

"A primary purpose of the cantillation signs which guide the chanting of the Torah is to provide information on the syntactical structure of the text. Some, however, say that the signs are a commentary on the text itself, highlighting important ideas musically. One such example is found in Parshat Re'eh.

Parshat Re'eh commands the giving of the tithes with the words "Aser Te'aser" - "tithe, surely tithe." Playing on

the verb, the Talmud in Tractate Ta'anit explains that the double-verb serves to teach that a person who tithes will surely become wealthy themselves. According to the Gaon of Vilna, this also explains why the cantillation of the word "Te'aser" in the Torah is a zakef-katon. The zakef-katon note, found very commonly in the Torah, literally means the upright-small. Therefore we learn that by giving the tithe, the small (the poor) will stand upright.
