Torah on Tour

Tzedakah by Rabbi Jarrod Grover

In the latter portion of Parashat Re'eh we read of the mitzvah of tzedakah: "Should there be amongst you a pauper... do not harden your heart or shut your hand against your needy brother. Open your hand generously." (Deut 15:7).

The Sages tell us that nature itself calls for a world that will always be composed of haves and have-nots, as the verse says, "for the poor shall never cease out of the land." (Deut 15:11). It is this very condition of inequity, perceived by

humans as an imperfection in God's world, which creates the basis for the mitzvah of tzedakah.

Why did God create a cruel world where people must beg and scrounge for even the barest necessities of survival? God, in His infinite wisdom, gives mankind a hand in building and sustaining the world ("the world is built with kindness"). It is only through acts of kindness that perceived imperfections are erased and the world becomes whole.

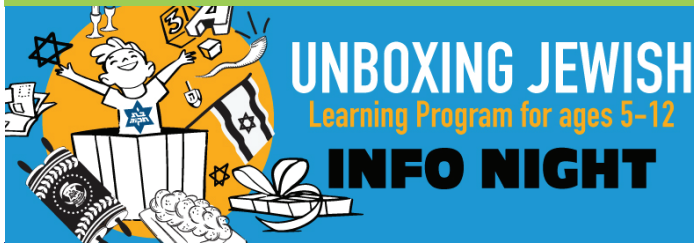

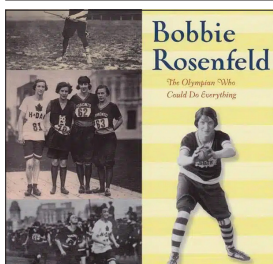
