Light of the Torah

Our Space by Rabbi Alisa Zilbershtein

Parshat Terumah focuses on the construction of the Mishkan, the portable sanctuary that the Israelites built in the desert. The parsha describes in great detail the materials that were needed to build the Mishkan and the specific instructions that were given to construct it.

One of the key themes that emerge from this parsha is the importance of giving generously and willingly. The Israelites were not forced to contribute to the building of the Mishkan but rather were invited to do so if they felt moved to give. The Torah says, "Tell the Israelite people to bring Me gifts; you shall accept gifts

for Me from every person whose heart is so moved." (Exodus 25:2). The concept of giving from the heart is a central one in Jewish tradition.

Another important lesson from this parsha is the value of creating a physical space for communal worship. The Mishkan was not just a place where the Israelites could bring offerings to God; it was also a central gathering place for the community. By coming together in the Mishkan, the Israelites were able to strengthen their bonds with one another and with God.

In our own lives, it is important to remember the value of giving generously and creating communal spaces where we can come together with others. Whether it is through charitable giving, volunteering, or simply being present for our friends and family, we can all find ways to give from the heart and build meaningful connections with others.

May we all be blessed to find joy and fulfillment in the act of giving and to create spaces of connection and community in our own lives.

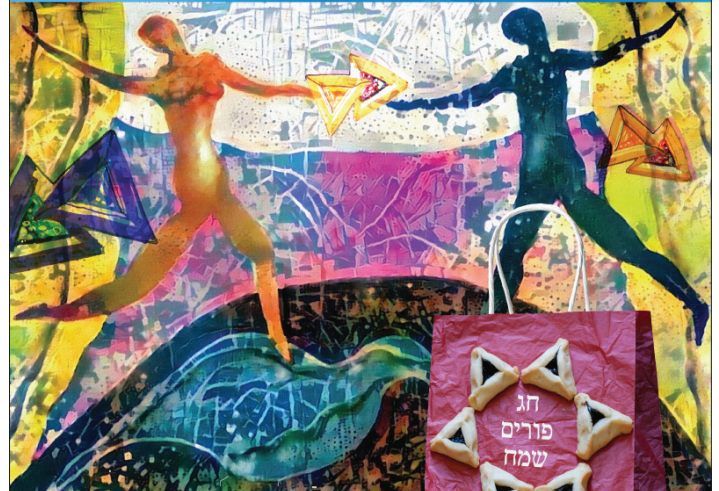

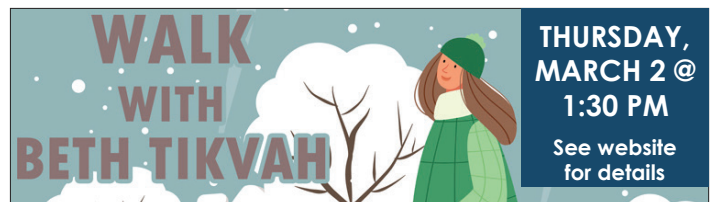
