Torah on

Constant Effort by Rabbi Jarrod Grover

The Talmud records two life phenomena that are equated with the splitting of the Reed Sea. In Tractate Pesahim, Rav Shizbi teaches that having a steady livelihood is as difficult to achieve as the splitting of the Reed Sea. And in Tractate Sanhedrin, Rabbah bar bar Channah teaches that having a good marriage is as difficult to achieve as the splitting of the Reed Sea.

What is the connection between marriage success and business success?

Everyone knows that just because a person made a living yesterday, there is no guarantee that he will make a living today. Making a living is something that a person must engage in constantly. He always needs to come up with new creative ways to keep and earn his livelihood -- new avenues of business, new

markets, etc., etc. Even if a person has a salaried position, he always needs to maintain his status and remain current with new trends and developments in his field or profession.

There can be no stagnation or "coasting along" when it comes to making a living. It has to be worked day in and day out.

This is the connection between a livelihood and a marriage. There can be no coasting in a marriage, just as there can be no coasting in a business. A business can go bankrupt after 30 years, and so can a marriage. A business must be constantly nurtured and expanded and taken care of and maintained. The same is true of a marriage.

Both require perpetual maintenance, which can be as difficult as the splitting of the sea!




