Light of the Torah

Entering the Promised Land by Rabbi Alisa Zilbershtein

This week, we read Parshat Devarim, the first portion of the final book of the Torah, Deuteronomy. As we begin this book, Moses addresses the Israelites, reflecting on the forty years they have spent wandering in the wilderness. Here, he revisits the past, recalling their victories, failures, and lessons learned along the journey. This speech sets the stage for the broader message of Devarim – a reflection and summary of the entire Torah thus far. But why now, on the brink of entering the Promised Land, does Moses choose to recount their past?

To answer this, let us consider the nature of the Israelites' journey. They have been both blessed and challenged - through miraculous escapes, Divine revelation, bitter disputes, and painful punishments. Their journey was not a straightforward path; it was marked by triumphs, setbacks, and lessons, much like our own lives.

Looking back can be uncomfortable. Our pasts are often laden with moments we'd rather forget, with failures that still sting, and with words or actions we regret. But as much as we may want to push away these unpleasant memories, they, too, form a critical part of our identity. Just

as the Israelites couldn't move into the Promised Land without acknowledging and learning from their past, so too we cannot grow without integrating all parts of our personal history.

As we read Parshat Devarim, let us remember that our past, with all its victories and defeats, serves as the foundation for our future. May we have the strength and courage to reflect on our history, to learn from it, and to move forward into our Promised Land, whatever that may be for each of us.

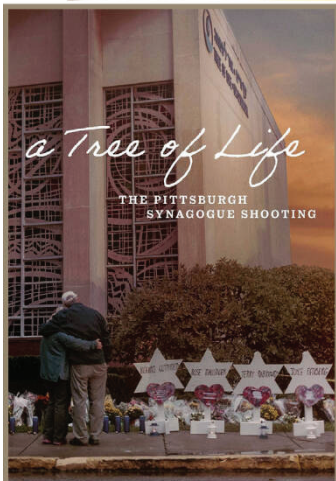

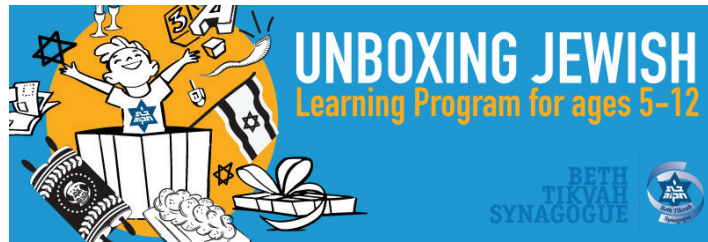
