At Kivrot Hataavah by Rabbi Jarrod Grover

At Kivrot Hata'avah, the Israelites expressed their yearning for the flesh pots of Egypt and dared Moses to provide for their immediate gratification. They voiced dissatisfaction with the manna from heaven: "If only we had meat to eat... we remember the fish we used to eat freely in Egypt, the cucumbers, the melons, the leeks, the onions, the garlic" (11:4-5).

Stunned by these gluttonous cravings and demands, Moses does not address their request directly. Instead, he cries out to God: "Why have you dealt ill with your servant... was it I who conceived this people... did I bear them? I cannot by myself carry all these people; it is too much for me. If You, Lord, would deal

thus with me, kill me...and let me see no more of my wretchedness" (11:11-15).

What caused Moses to unleash such a torrent of frustration?

Rabbi Joseph Soloveitchik zt"l points out that Kivrot Hata'avah represents the people's regression into a pagan way of life. Torah is about the individual submitting to a moral, ethical and religious discipline. "Judaism teaches that man's divine image manifests itself in his self-control, in his subordination of cravings and lusts, to the will of G-d." The Kivrot Hata'avah episode revealed that the Egyptians' pagan lifestyle had caught hold of the Israelites.

The commentaries suggest that an earlier

verse - "And they marched from the mountain of the Lord" (10:33) - alludes to the cause of Israel's backsliding. The "mountain" refers to Sinai and all it signifies. The implication is that the message of Sinai had not been internalized. The people heard the words, but they failed to assimilate the message and allow it to register into their personal lives.


A truly religious person does not merely live by rules, but more importantly, integrates their values into their lifestyle. In this manner, Sinai is not merely an historic event. It is an everlasting inspiration that enriches and deepens a person's service to God in every aspect of human behavior.
