Transformational Prayer by Rabbi Jarrod Grover

Why did Moses have to pray to God not to accept the offering of Korach? Inasmuch as he knew that Korach was defying the Divine will, was it not self-evident that God would not accept this offering?

The effectiveness of prayer is not easily explained. While some aspects of prayer may be beyond our grasp, one of the explanations is that prayer is not intended to bring about a change in God, but in the supplicant.

A woman who was devastated when her newborn child turned out to have a genetic issue, related that she had

prayed fervently: "Please God, You have performed so many miracles, do just one more, change him." She went on to say, "one day the miracle occurred: God changed me."

What she was really saying was that ultimately her prayers helped her accept God's will. We can now understand that Moses, finding himself in a state of distress, did what the Torah prescribes: He prayed for Divine assistance. Moshe's prayer, like all sincere prayer, was not intended to bring about any changes in God, but in himself. That is what all prayers should do.

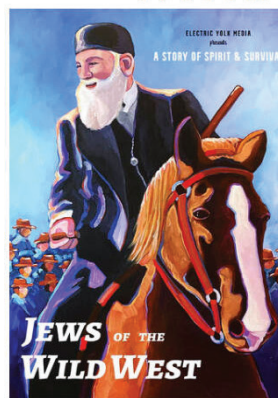


