# Light of the Torah



In Parshat Ki Tisa, we learn about the sin of the Golden Calf, which was a turning point in the relationship between God and the Israelites. Moshe had gone up the mountain to receive the rest of the Torah, and while he was gone, the Israelites became impatient and built a Golden Calf to worship.

The first lesson is easy to understand — we learn from this story about the danger of idolatry. The Israelites made the mistake of replacing their faith in God with the worship of an idol. They forgot so fast that it was God who had rescued them from slavery and had performed

miraculous deeds to show them His power and might.

But the second lesson lies in the community fallout that followed the Sin of Golden Calf. In our lives, we may not worship idols in the same way as the Israelites did, but we can still be guilty of putting other things before God. We may place too much importance on material possessions, wealth and other mundane goals. We may also allow our egos to get in the way that sustains our community, thinking that we are self-sufficient and do not need other Jews and that other Jews don't need us. This is the invisible

idolatry that goes unnoticed. Yet our community is the reflection of God's presence on Earth. The Sin of Golden Calf split the Israelites in the wilderness and they turned against one another. It is a harsh warning.

Parshat Ki Tisa reminds us that "idolatry" endangers not only our personal relationships with God but also the bond of our community. May we all strive to follow these lessons and live our lives in a way that bring us closer to the Divine and to each other.


March 13th, April 24th, May 8th & May 29th

Together we can prepare sandwiches, that will be distributed to the homeless by Ve'ahavta's outreach vans.




