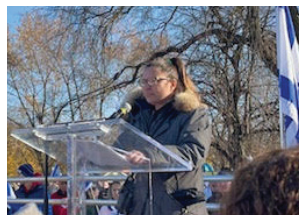

Our hearts have been breaking since October 7th, 2023 when we learned that one of our own soldiers, Alon, was kidnapped along with his wife and 3 year old daughter.

Luckily, Alon managed to escape with his daughter, but his wife and sister were not as lucky.

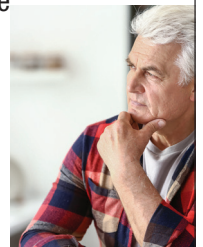
